In pursuance of the Home & Hill Affairs Department, Govt. of West Bengal Memorandum No. 3416/PA/14M-39/18 dated 22.11.2018, whereas it is necessary in the interest of public service and in an attempt to judiciously dispose long-pending traffic cases, it is hereby notified that a new One Time Traffic Fine Settlement Scheme is formulated for the public which shall provide an opportunity to clear the outstanding fines and at the same time avail the benefits of this scheme within the stipulated time frame as prescribed below-

1. Public shall have the opportunity to clear pending backlog of traffic cases registered up to **15-11-2018**.
2. The first phase of the scheme shall come into force from **01-12-2018** and will remain operational up to **14-01-2019** and the second phase of the scheme shall come into force from **15-01-2019** and will remain operational till **13-02-2019**.
3. The aforementioned One Time Traffic Fine Settlement Scheme shall comprise two (02) Phases.
 - (i) **PHASE-I** shall become operational from **01-12-2018** to **14-01-2019** and within this 45 days period, public shall only have to pay **35%** of the total dues and be eligible for **65%** waiver.
 - (ii) **PHASE-II** shall become operational from **15-01-2019** to **13-02-2019** and within this 30 days period, public shall only have to pay **50%** of the total dues and be eligible for **50%** waiver.

Phase-I will come into force from **01-12-2018** and will continue till **14-01- 2019** and
Phase-II will come into force from **15-01-2019** and will continue till **13-02- 2019**.
