



Traffic Advisory



A portion of the **Nirmal Chandra Street (50 metres towards North from Lenin Sarani)** will be closed from **22.00 hrs of 01.04.2022** for construction of Intermediate Ventilation Shafts at Subodh Mallick Square for Kolkata East West Metro project undertaken by the Kolkata Metro Rail Corporation Limited. In view to facilitate the above mentioned work, notice is hereby given for the information of public that vehicle circulation pattern along Nirmal Chandra Street and its adjoining Roads/ Streets during traffic closure of the said stretch will be made in the following manners to facilitate the work :-

❖ **South bound vehicles of N C Street:**

- Buses of Route No. 78/1, 46, 234/1, 34/B and 217A, availing N C Street south bound from B B Ganguly Street side, will be diverted from N C Street/ B B Ganguly Street Crossing to avail B B Ganguly Street – C R Avenue.
- South bound small vehicles of N C Street will be diverted from N C Street/G C Avenue crossing either via G C Avenue towards West – C R Avenue or via RSM Square towards East.

❖ **North bound vehicles of N C Street:**

- Buses of Route No. 78/1, 46, 234/1, 34/B and 217A, availing N C Street north bound from Lenin Sarani side, will be diverted from J L Nehru/ Lenin Sarani Crossing (Esplanade Crossing) to avail C R Avenue – Colootola Street – College Street.
 - North bound small vehicles of N C Street will avail their normal route from Lenin Sarani side along 3.5 metres carriageway on the western flank of N C Street.
- ❖ Movement of **Tram cars** along N C Street will be suspended / restricted from 01.04.2022 till completion of the proposed work.
- ❖ Vehicular traffic may also be diverted from any of the arterial and feeder roads by traffic police on duty as and when considered necessary.
- ❖ These regulations will be enforced in addition to the other normal restrictions on these days which are not repugnant to the above.

This will come into force from **22.00 hrs of 01.04.2022** and will continue till completion of the work. Published in the interest of public by Kolkata Metro Rail Corporation Limited and Kolkata Police.
